

## YOUTH MEASURES

### Placement in Employment or Education

Of those who are not in post-secondary education, employment or the military at the date of participation:

**56%** must be placed in employment, military or enrolled in post-secondary education, advanced training, or occupational skills training in the first quarter after the exit quarter.

Method of measurement:

Number of participants who are in employment or the military or enrolled in post-secondary education and/or advanced training/occupational skills training in the first quarter after the exit quarter

---

Number of participants who exit during the quarter

### Attainment of a Degree or Certificate

Of those enrolled in education (at the date of participation or at any point during the program):

**56%** must attain a diploma, GED, or certificate by the end of the third quarter after the exit quarter.

Method of measurement:

Number of participants who attain a diploma, GED, or certificate by the end of the third quarter after the exit quarter.

Number of participants who exit during the quarter

### Out of School Youth – Literacy and Numeracy Gains

Of those out of school youth who are basic skills deficient (score below 9<sup>th</sup> grade level in Reading or Math):

**45%** shall increase one or more educational functioning levels

Method of Measurement

Number of participants who increase one or more educational functioning levels

---

Number of participants who have completed a year in the program (i.e. one year from the date of program participation) plus the number of participants who exit before completing a year in the program
